












Happy 2019 to all of our beloved Options' family.

Last year was a year of great sadness for us all here at Options. The death of Davida deeply affected us all. Our mission is clear, though, and that is to carry on her legacy.

As we enter 2019, I am celebrating my twentieth year at Options. I am one of our eleven thousand who have passed through our doors since 1996. The Options program is one of a kind, providing treatment-on-demand with the highest quality of services. In 2018 we added our innovative reception center programming in three California prisons and are now housing women with children in our new Alice Street property in Oakland. These new projects continue to fill the need in the spirit of our founder. We serve the un-served regardless of ability to pay. Government funding such as the Affordable Care Act and pay-for-service contracts cover only about 70% of our costs. The rest, over a million dollars per year, we need to raise ourselves. This is where we need your help. Addiction does not take a day off and waiting lists can cause death.



In addition, in 2019 we are beginning a capital campaign to expand our housing to continue to meet the demand for safe and drug free recovery residences in our community. We challenge all of our Options supporters and government agencies to match the \$1 million legacy gift by our longtime supporters Raul and Sherry Deju in honor of Davida. I myself have included Options in my living trust. These pledges can be leveraged now to support our capital fund drive. Please contact the Options development office if you would like assistance in establishing such a legacy donation.

For 2019 I wish the best to you all from my heart and my thanks for your ongoing generosity. You got us where we are today.
